- Researching, analyzing and evaluating economic or sociological issues
- Forecasting
- Applying, analyzing and evaluating statistics, survey methods and systems
- Developing, analyzing and interpreting qualitative and quantitative data, reviewing legislation or conducting studies
- Planning surveys and censuses
- Determining statistical measures and techniques for analyzing and reporting data
- Providing advice in the fields of economics, sociology and statistics
