- To increase the capacity to respond to the demand for language-related products and services in New Brunswick and the other Atlantic provinces.
- To increase the qualified workforce.
- To increase access to the tools and technological infrastructure relevant to this field.
- To strengthen partnerships between the different levels of government and the community.
- To raise awareness of the positive benefits of the language industry services for Acadian and Francophone communities and businesses.

- Increased number of professionals working in Translation and Interpretation.
- Improved language industry services to Acadian and Francophone communities in the Atlantic Region
